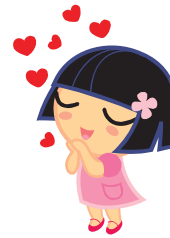

# Keeping you Informed...

Public health officials within the United States and throughout the world are investigating outbreaks of swine influenza (swine flu). Swine flu is a respiratory disease of pigs caused by a type A influenza virus that regularly causes outbreaks of influenza among pigs. While swine flu viruses do not normally infect humans: causes of swine flu infection in human have occurred. Public health officials have determined that this strain of swine flu virus spreads from human to human and can cause illness.

The **symptoms of swine flu** in people are similar to symptoms of seasonal flu in humans and may include: Fever (greater than 100F or 37.8C ) Sore throat, Cough, Stuffy nose, Chills, Headache and body aches, Fatigue.

To prevent the spread of swine flu:

Avoid contact with ill persons, when you cough or sneeze, cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or your sleeve (if you do not have a tissue). Throw used tissues in a trash can. After you cough or sneeze, wash your hands with soap and water, or use an alcohol-based hand gel if you think you are ill with flu, avoid close contact with others as much as possible. Stay at home. Seek medical care if you are severely ill (such as having trouble breathing). There are antiviral medications for prevention and treatment of swine flu that a doctor can prescribe. Do not go to work, school, or travel while ill.
